The NEA Foundation Awards for Teaching Excellence (ATE) recognize educators for their excellence in the classroom and their leadership beyond the schools' walls. Nominees for these annual awards are drawn from all 50 states and from the U.S. Department of Defense schools.

The NEA Foundation presents three additional awards at the Salute to Excellence, honoring special friends of public education for their commitments to the field.

## AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO PUBLIC EDUCATION

The Award for Outstanding Service to Public Education honors those who have significantly increased understanding of the value of public education or dedicated themselves to

serving public school educators and students.

## EQUITY PARTNER AWARD

A well-resourced public education should be every child's civil right but there are widespread inequities in education based on economic status, race, ethnicity, and geography. The Equity Partner Award honors an individual or organization that takes action to address equity and opportunity gaps in public education.

## STUDENT VOICES FOR EDUCATION AWARD

Across our country, students play a significant role in advocating for improvements in public education. The Student Voices for Education Award recognizes an individual or group of students, or an organization that is providing exemplary leadership in elevating student voices and building student movements to advocate for stronger public schools.

# YOUR PARTNERSHIP HELPS THE NEA FOUNDATION DRIVE LASTING CHANGE

An investment in public education and public school educators is an investment in a brighter future for our children and a strong and vital democracy. Your contribution to the Salute to Excellence in Education supports critical NEA Foundation priorities.

Since 2010, The NEA Foundation has invested more than **\$39 million** in grants to educators for professional growth and innovation and in special initiatives to strengthen public education in school districts around the country.

## FUEL EDUCATORS' AND STUDENTS' LEARNING

Our Grants to Educators program serves public school educators in communities around the country. Through Envision Equity, Student Success, and Learning & Leadership grants, the Foundation supports innovative classroom projects, educator-led collaborations, and teachers' professional development.

**By the numbers since 2010:** More than **\$7.7** million in grants awarded benefiting over **84,000** educators and **1.7** million students across the country

## CREATE LEADERS FOR THE GLOBAL AGE

Each year, our Global Learning Fellowship engages up to 50 K-12 public school educators in a year-long immersive professional development and learning program. They emerge as leaders ready to bring the world into their classrooms and equip their students for global citizenship in the 21st century.

**By the numbers, since 2010:** **455** Global Learning Fellows, **228** free classroom resources provided to educators, **41,500** hours of professional development for educators

## CLOSE OPPORTUNITY GAPS

Today, 25 million students in public schools live in under-resourced households, the highest proportion in generations. Some regions, notably the American South, lag far behind the national average of a dollar per pupil in funding, with investments dropping as low as 30 cents per pupil. This contributes to a widening opportunity gap that disproportionately impacts low-income, Black and Brown students. The NEA Foundation's Community Schools Initiative is addressing gaps in educational equity and access by investing in the development of community schools in Arkansas, Louisiana, and Mississippi.

**By the numbers since launching in 2020, the Initiative has:** Supported the development of **19** community schools, created the Southern Regional Alliance for Community Schools network, served more than **10,000** students and their families

## SUPPORT CHANGEMAKERS

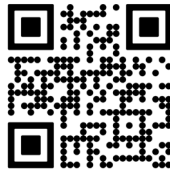
